

Red Roo Releases Model 2012 Chipper

MELBOURNE, May 2008 -- Red Roo Sales & Service Company Pty Ltd is pleased to announce the release of the Model 2012 chipper.

“We are excited to get the 2012 out here and look forward to getting the industry behind the product,” says Sean Kerr of Red Roo. “The months of planning and work by both Carlton and Red Roo have paid off - this machine is a winner.”

The 2012 is specification built by the JP Carlton Company for Red Roo and the Australian market.

A 140hp (104kW) John Deere® 4045 series, 4.5l, 4-cylinder, turbocharged diesel engine with air to air inter-cooling powers the 2012. A Murphy PowerVue controller and user configurable auto-reverse feed system are standard.

Standard equipment on the 2012 includes a live, twin pump hydraulic system. Each variable pressure compensated pump powers its own 32cc feed wheel motor delivering unprecedented feed wheel power. The design allows each feed wheel to act independently. The single hydraulic manifold design eliminates potential leaks by having a central point of connection and keeps all hoses neat. A hydraulic winch kit, spare tyre and 6 LED beacon are also fitted.

The infeed throat is a massive 12.75” (324mm) high and 20” (508mm) wide and combined with the 64” (1.63m) wide feed opening, allows easy feeding of the most awkward material. A 2012 exclusive is a continuous feed button to allow difficult material to continue feeding regardless of feed bar position.



Red Roo and JP Carlton have worked together to deliver a machine built for the Australian market. All winch controls have been moved kerb side, lighting is ADR compliant Hella® LED, dual operation controls allow operation from either side and towing packages have been upgraded to full Australian Design Rule standard.

“When these machines leave the Carlton factory in Spartanburg, SC,” says Kerr, “our customers may rest assured that not only the importer, but the factory has taken interest to ensure all ADR requirements have been met and the unit is presented to the buyer as a machine made for Australia, not subject to an attempt at compliance once it arrives on shore.”
